As signage coordinator, I utilized as many signs from the previous show as possible. Most of the outside signage was purposely undated with only the words Quilt Show Sat and Sun with appropriate arrows pointing the way.

We have eight (8) wire and corrugated plastic lawn signs that were donated. These are used as "direction" signs. Also there is a sandwich board that is displayed at the venue with quilt show/Sat. and Sun. with hours posted.

For the Raffle Quilt, Basket Raffle, Admissions, Ballot box and Boutique new signs were made with foam core poster board, and a bill presented to the Treasurer.

Interior signage for restrooms, please do not touch quilts, etc. I used my computer and printer.

The time factor for this task was previous to the show; directional signage needs to be placed in strategic places, for example, near the high way and at crossroads. Before the show opens any interior signage needs to be in place.

In Bridgewater no sign permit is required. The new coordinator should investigate this cost should we change venues.
